After two bounce-back victories, the eighth-ranked Clarkson University Women's Hockey team will try to continue the momentum against conference opponents as Harvard and Dartmouth come to Potsdam for the opening weekend of ECAC Hockey play at Cheel Arena.

Led by ninth-year head coach Matt Desrosiers and assistant coaches Britni Smith and Tony Maci, Clarkson is 4-3-1 through the first four weeks of the season. Last weekend saw the Golden Knights go on the road and earn consecutive 3-1 wins over the University of New Hampshire.

- On Saturday, Clarkson was in an early 1-0 hole against the Wildcats, but a goal by captain Savannah Harmon tied the game and then Corie Jacobson's career-high third goal gave Clarkson the lead. Michaela Pejzlova added an insurance goal for the Green and Gold in the third period.
- Sunday's game was the inverse of Saturday's as Clarkson jumped out to a 1-0 lead on a goal by Jessica Gillham. Harmon added a goal to make the score 2-0 after the first period. New Hampshire cut the lead in half, but Harmon struck again to give Clarkson a 3-1 cushion. It was the first multi-goal game of Harmon's collegiate career.
- Along with Harmon, fellow captain Cayley Mercer recorded three points in the two games against New Hampshire and now has a team high seven points on two goals and five assists. Mercer now has 123 career points which is the fifth best total in Clarkson history.
- Clarkson has struggled on the power-play this season, converting just 12 percent of its opportunities. That rate is the 20th best in the country while the Golden Knights' penalty kill is 23rd, with a percentage of 83.0. Rhyen McGill and Josiane Pozzebon have been the bright spots on the power-play with the pair scoring two extra man goals apiece. That puts both McGill and Pozzebon in a tie for ninth in the nation in power-play goals.
- Jacobson, Bannon, Harmon, and Pozzebon all have one game-winning goal this season. The quartet are all tied for 11th in the country in that category. Also on the national leaderboards is Harmon who is 22nd in points per game among defensemen and Jacobson who is tied for 27th in the same category. Pejzlova and Ella Shelton are both tied for 40th in the country in points per game among rookies.

•Harvard comes into the weekend with just one game under its belt, a 5-1 win at conference rival Dartmouth. After finishing in a tie with Clarkson for first in the ECAC in 2014-2015, the Crimson dropped to fifth place in 2015-2016 and was picked to finish in the same spot in the preseason coach's poll. Sydney Daniels is the leading returning scorer for Harvard and already has three goals after a hat trick against the Big Green. After the graduation of Emerance Maschmeyer, Brianna Laing steps in as the starting goaltender and has a 19-2-1 career record in three seasons with a .941 save percentage and 1.41 goals against average.

• Dartmouth is still looking for its first win of the season after a 3-0 loss against Northeastern and then a 5-1 loss to Harvard. The Big Green finished in tenth place in the ECAC in 2015-16 and was picked to finish tenth in the preseason coach's poll. It was the first time that Dartmouth missed the conference playoffs since 2010. Dartmouth returns just one of its top four scorers, in Kennedy Ottenbreit who racked up 20 points in her junior season. Robyn Chemago does return for her senior season with a 19-37-5 career record in goal.

After trailing early, three straight goals lifted eighth-ranked Clarkson to a 3-1 road victory at New Hampshire. Clarkson returns to .500 with a 3-3-1 record while New Hampshire falls to 1-6-0. The Wildcats took the lead only 42 seconds into the game. Amy Schlager opened the scoring off a pass from Taylor Wenczkowski with Jonna Curtis also getting an assist. Clarkson did not tie the game until the second period, but captain Savannah Harmon's goal opened the floodgates for the Golden Knights. Harmon's score came at 3:58 in the middle frame after assistant captain Genevieve Bannon gathered the puck on the boards and then passed to Harmon who was alone at the top of the slot. Harmon was able to take the pass and fire into the net to tie the game. The Green and Gold took the lead at 15:35 off a goal from Corie Jacobson. Captain Cayley Mercer got the assist on the goal. Clarkson added an insurance goal at 2:44 in the third period with Michaela Pejzlova second career score. Clarkson finished with a 35-23 advantage in shots. Neither team could score in their five power-play opportunities. Shea Tiley made 22 stops for Clarkson in goal while Kyra Smith had 32 for the Wildcats.

An early lead was enough to carry eighth-ranked Clarkson to a second consecutive 3-1 victory over New Hampshire on Sunday afternoon. While on Saturday, the Wildcats scored early in the game, on Sunday the Golden Knights flipped the script with a goal only 55 seconds into the game. It was Jessica Gillham who scored, with the goal being her first of the season. Lauren Lefler and Cassidy Vinkle contributed the assists on the score. At the 12:49, the Green and Gold doubled their lead. For the second consecutive game Savannah Harmon found the back of the net. Gillham and Vinkle both picked up their second points of the day with assists. The Wildcats got a little hope back 5:17 into the second period when Jonna Curtis scored a power-play goal to cut Clarkson's lead in half. However, just 25 seconds later, Clarkson's lead was again two as Harmon bagged her second goal of the game. It was Cayley Mercer and Loren Gabel who set up the goal with assists. Clarkson held a 44-26 edge in shots and are now 4-0-0 this season when outshooting opponents. The Golden Knights were 0-8 on the power-play while New Hampshire finished one of six. Shea Tiley played 47:16 in goal, making 20 saves. McKenzie Johnson played 11:48 and had five stops. Hillary Cashin had 41 saves for New Hampshire.
